CobbFendley is responsible for coordinating the relocations for all utilities along US 290 from Loop 610 to FM 2920. Tasks include researching and identifying conflicts with the proposed roadway and drainage design, preparing a utility corridor conceptual plan, conducting coordination meetings with TxDOT and the design team, preparing and reviewing Utility Agreement Assemblies, providing constructability reviews, designing relocation plans, coordinating utility relocation schedules with the roadway construction schedule, and reimbursing utilities for relocation work.

Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) services included Quality Levels D, C, B and A for approximately 150,000 LF of utilities and over 75 test holes, including 12 pipeline companies, 4 Municipal Utility Districts and the City of Houston, 14 telecommunication companies and TxDOT Computerized Traffic Management System. All SUE information is tied to a GIS database.
