

SH 195 - South of Bell County Line to IH 35

Williamson County, Texas

CobbFendley is providing utility coordination and subsurface utility engineering (SUE) services for Williamson County for this 17-mile road-widening project.

CobbFendley's tasks include subsurface utility engineering to map all utilities along the corridor, researching and identifying conflicts with the proposed roadway and drainage design, preparing a Utility Corridor Conceptual Plan for the project, conducting coordination meetings with each utility owner, TxDOT, and the design team, reviewing utility agreement assemblies for each utility, providing constructability reviews for each relocation design, coordinating utility relocation schedules with the roadway construction schedule, and reimbursing utilities for relocation work.

Project highlights include the following:

- All utility relocations for Segment 1 were complete prior to the project letting, which included Chisholm Trail Special Utility District, Oncor Electric, Pedernales Electric Cooperative, City of Florence, and CenturyLink
- Coordinated and secured LCRA transmission line agreements for the project ahead of schedule to ensure timely completion of this major relocation effort
- Coordination of utility easements and right-of-way for several relocating utilities
